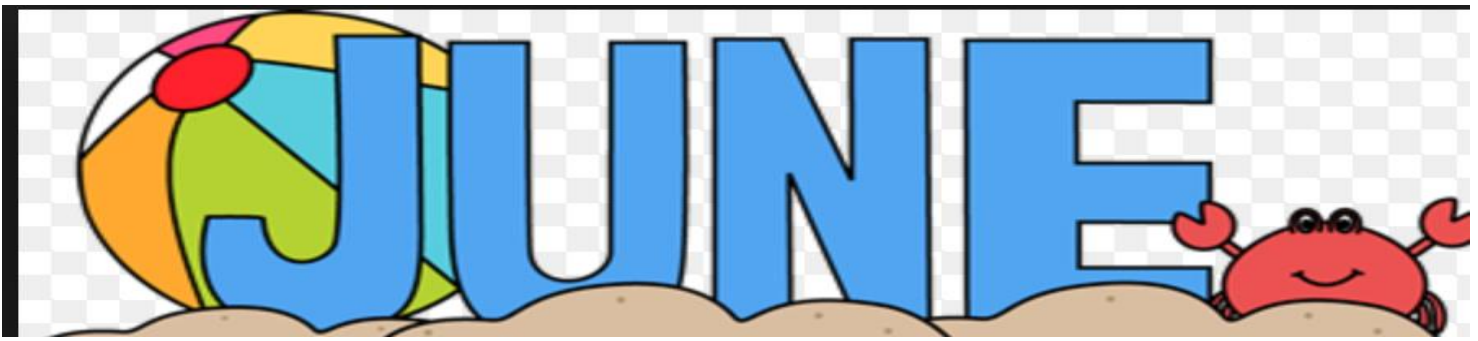
AP US History
