MASK MANDATE

Governor Inslee announced that the state's indoor mask mandate will be lifted beginning March 12, 2022. This includes inside our schools and on our school buses. This means that beginning Monday, March 14, masks will be optional for students and staff in our schools and on our buses. Masks remain a requirement for all students, staff, volunteers, and visitors inside our schools and on school buses through March 11.
