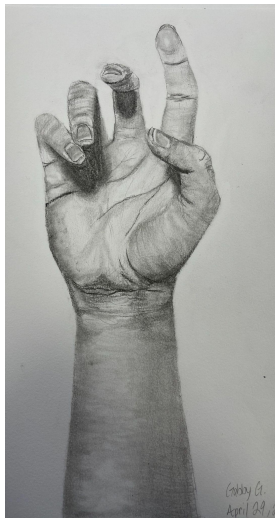
## Interested in law, justice, the court system? Looking for a meaningful volunteer opportunity?
